Sbani is 5 years old and has Cerebral Palsy. Because of his condition he cannot speak and is totally reliant on caregivers for all his needs. Because he could also not sit upright by himself he felt unhappy, alone and isolated from the other children.

A "Bumbo rubber chair" was purchased for Sbani which allows him to sit upright and play with toys and the other children. Sbani is now a happy child and with ongoing physiotherapy the goal is to increase his muscle tone so that he has more control over his body and socialization will assist with development of his speech.

Developmental Therapy is an important part of the care of Disabled Children at the Mark Adamsson Centre and ensures that every child is developed to his or her full potential and that they enjoy quality of life.
